Dear parents,

Welcome back, we hope you had a lovely break and the children are all relaxed and ready for this half term.

Our topic this half term is 'Animals.'

In Literacy we will be working hard on using our knowledge of letters and sounds in reading and writing, developing the skills already learnt and progressing to writing independently where appropriate. We will also be writing poems, researching animals and writing letters based on the story 'Dear Zoo.' We will continue to develop speaking and listening skills through 'Show and Tell' on a Tuesday.

In Numeracy we will be working on writing, ordering and recognising numbers to 20. We will work on problem solving and using positional language.

Could all children please have a named water bottle in school as soon as possible as the children are starting to get thirsty after play times as it gets a bit warmer!

Junior school clubs- these will start next Week. We would like to apologise as we are aware that some children have been disappointed not to be able to have their first choice or get a space in a club. Due to safety and resources we must keep clubs to a maximum of 15 children which means we cannot accommodate all children.
