### YEAR 7 & 9 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD 2009

#### Who is eligible?

A girl or boy

- who will be entering year 7 or 9 in September 2009

The applicant must be able to demonstrate excellence by

- above average academic ability
- good levels of self motivation and enthusiasm for learning
- leadership and communication skills
- the ability to make a significant contribution to the life of the school in at least ONE of the following fields of music, art, sport.

Only one scholarship will be awarded per candidate.

#### How are scholarship pupils selected?

- by interview and other assessments in January 2009
- all candidates will take a written English paper, a written Maths paper, an IQ test,
- by taking part in a team building exercise,
- interviews will be with the Principal, or Vice Principal and members of staff involved in any activity of particular interest to the candidate
- all candidates require written advocacy from their form tutor if s/he is an internal candidate or a reference from the Head teacher of an external candidate's current school, plus one external reference.

#### When will the scholarship be awarded?

The Principal will inform the candidates' parents/ guardians of the results by telephone and then confirmed in writing.

#### How does a candidate apply?

### ***Music Scholarships***

Normally candidates for the year 7 award will be expected to perform on two instruments. Singing may be offered as one of these. Candidates will justify their scholarship by acting as an example to others through their high level of motivation and positive contribution to all aspects of school life. They will be expected to enter competitions and be in a school choir and/or in the orchestra.

Scholars must maintain their standard or forfeit their scholarship. Their award will be reviewed at the end of each Summer term and parents/guardians will be informed in writing of the outcome at the end of the Summer term.

Invited candidates will come for an assessment day and audition at Arnold Lodge in January. Candidates are expected to bring and play on their own instruments.

## **Scholarship Awards 2009**

### ***Art Scholarships***

For candidates of year 7 or 9 scholarships we are also interested in the development of creative ideas. Candidates will justify their scholarship by entering competitions as well as sharing their love of art and acting as an example to others through their high level of motivation and positive contribution to all aspects of school life.

Scholars must maintain their standard or forfeit their scholarship. Their award will be reviewed at the end of each Summer term and parents/guardians will be informed in writing of the outcome at the end of the Summer term.

Invited candidates will come for an assessment day at Arnold Lodge in January and are invited to bring with them a portfolio of recent work.

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## **Selection procedures**

- **Academic ability** through references and assessment
- **Attitudes** through interviews and references
- **Specific field** through application portfolios/evidence and observations, references

### **a) Academic ability**

Candidates will be expected to be operating at a level well above average, ie at level 6 in key stage 2 for year 7 scholarships and Common Entrance level for year 9 scholarships.

Evidence from **school** should demonstrate this through end of year exams if applicable, SATs preparation scores, VR scores and any other assessments as deemed appropriate.

Having established the suitability of a prospective scholar, the candidate will be invited to attend an assessment day.

### **Academic assessment at Arnold Lodge**

1. English. Pupils will be expected to respond to a set text.
2. Maths. Pupils will be involved in a problem solving activity.
3. IQ test.

The relevant departments will prepare and mark the tasks and set the achievement band by which the prospective scholar will be considered further.

### **b) Self motivation and enthusiasm for learning**

Candidates will be expected to have demonstrated self motivation and enthusiasm for learning. Evidence for this can be gathered from the reference in term of clubs, extra curricular activities, involvement in wider aspects of the school and community.

### **Attitudinal assessment at Arnold Lodge**

Additional evidence will be assessed by interview with a member of the SMT and may include, the ability to communicate an interest, demonstrating knowledge and understanding, the ability to reflect upon current affairs, philosophical or moral issues.

### **c) Leadership and communication skills assessment at Arnold Lodge**

The candidate will take part in an exercise, observed by two members of staff, who will be looking for the ability to focus on the task, organise, communicate effectively with other members involved in the task, inspire and use the abilities within the team to achieve the goal.

#### **d) Specific Scholarship field**

**Music.** Candidates will show considerable natural ability, talent, proficiency and potential in playing at least one instrument, or in singing. Normally candidates for the award will be expected to perform on two instruments. Singing may be offered as one of these.

References from music teachers should accompany the school reference, referring where appropriate to participation in ensembles, choirs, public performances and practical examination grades obtained. In addition, reference should be made to aural skills, musicianship and sight reading ability.

#### **Music assessment at Arnold Lodge**

The Director of Music will lead the interview which will include playing /singing 2 contrasting pieces of candidate's own choice. Tests will also be given to assess aural and sight reading skills. Candidates are expected to bring and play on their own instruments.

**Sport.** By sport it is understood to be team games i.e. netball, hockey, cricket, rugby, football. Candidates will show considerable natural ability, talent, proficiency and potential in playing at least one sport.

References from sports teachers should accompany the school reference, referring where appropriate to participation in teams, clubs and associations, and successes in competitions.

#### **Sport assessment at Arnold Lodge**

The Head of PE will lead the assessment which will include a fitness test, skill test and participation in sporting activities.

**Art.** Candidates will show considerable natural ability, talent, proficiency and potential in art.

References from art teachers should accompany the school reference, referring where appropriate to participation in exhibitions, competitions, team and club membership.

#### **Art assessment at Arnold Lodge**

A member of the art department will lead the assessment which will include a simple practical exercise. The candidate will proffer for review and discussion a portfolio of work undertaken in the last year. A knowledge of art and artists will be discussed as part of the interview process.
