Year 3 visit to Compton Verney Art Gallery

As part of a curriculum link between Art and Geography, we will be taking the Year 3 children to Compton Verney.

The children will take part in a 'Pattern, Shape and design' workshop linked with both their Art topic on Patterns and their Geography topic on India. They will become a textile designer for the day, exploring fabulous textile designs in the Enid Marx collection and recording patterns and shapes to inspire their own stencil-printed piece. Then working in teams they will create a silk-screen printed panel using their own designs. Back in school this will link with a tie-dye and printing project and learning more about the textile industry in India.

We will leave school at 9am on **Wednesday 30th November** and return to school in time for normal pick up. Children should be in full uniform and will need a packed lunch, preferably fully disposable, no fizzy drinks etc. There will be an opportunity to visit the shop; we suggest £5.00 as a maximum, in a clearly named purse.

The cost of the trip is £18 and will appear on next term's fees. Please return the consent form to school, noting any change to your contact details if necessary.
